Calvary Chapel Lakeside **Statement of Faith**

We believe that all men are sinners by nature and by practice, being alienated from God; man is unable to remedy his lost condition in and of himself.

We believe that salvation is the gift of God brought to man by grace and received by personal trust in Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour. Those who have so trusted Christ are indwelt by the Holy Spirit and enabled to live a Godly life through submission to Him.

We believe that the Holy Spirit is a person. He is God and possesses all the divine attributes. He indwells all Believers, baptizes, imparts gifts (charismata) as He wills.

We believe unconfessed sin and unrepented hearts brings interruption in fellowship with God, bringing the loving discipline of the Heavenly Father.

Revisited

In comparison to the size of a ship a rudder is very small yet it possesses tremendous power. James tells us in his epistle, "... take ships as an example. Although they are so large and are driven by strong winds, they are steered by a very small rudder wherever the pilot wants to go. (James 3:4,NIV) We are instructed in the book of James that if we are able to control our tongue we are 'perfect'. Failure to use our tongue in a Godly fashion can cause our lives to be ruined (James 3:6). One of our life long goals as Christians should be to perfect our speech. We have the ability to bless others by just a few words or cause a life of grief through harsh language. Read and meditate on Ephesians 4:29. Something to think about...
